



Call for participants 4th edition of GREDEG Ph.D. Workshop For all GREDEG PhD students

GREDEG, Amphitheatre Turgot, Sophia Antipolis

January 17-18, 2024

Deadline for response to the call: <u>December 17, 2023</u>

The GREDEG Ph.D. Workshop is organized by the laboratory's doctoral students and is open to all Ph.D. students attached to GREDEG. It is an opportunity for Ph.D. students to communicate on their research, at any level of progress, to enjoy a moment of knowledge sharing and to enrich the laboratory's research. For first-year doctoral students, it represents an ideal occasion to introduce their work and to encourage exchanges with laboratory members.

Note: a buffet lunch¹ will be available. Hot drinks and sweets will also be available during breaks between sessions.

The presentation format is as follows:

15 minutes presentation + 5 to 10 minutes discussion.

The call is open to all PhD students. First-year doctoral students may choose to present only their thesis project or more advanced work. For other PhD students, it will be necessary to present more advanced work.

Guidelines for presentations:

- 1- The participant can choose to present in French or English, but it is mandatory to have slides in English to reach a broader audience. The use of visual aids is recommended to facilitate understanding of the subject by PhD students from other disciplines (law, economics, management and sociology).
- 2- Presentations by doctoral students **must be in person** (except in special cases). In addition, although a hybrid format is planned, the presence of thesis supervisors, discussants² and spectators is strongly recommended.

¹ Compatible with all dietary regimes.

² A discussant is a researcher who will give an analysis of your paper and provide suggestions for improvement. He or she can belong to any university, but if he or she is not from the Université Côte d'Azur and agrees to travel, GREDEG will pay for his or her visit.





- 3- **Discussants are mandatory for all presentations**. First-year doctoral students presenting their thesis project may, if they wish, ask a second-year doctoral student or above to be their discussant.
- 4- PhD students must provide a **written summary** of their presentation no later than **February 8**, **2024**. All written material collected at the end of the workshop will be compiled into a document (in the form of a "Cahier du GREDEG PhD Workshop") for further use. This booklet will then be available on the GREDEG website. The aim is to perpetuate this event, by keeping a written record of the presentations. In addition, PhD students will be able to record their presentation and/or the ensuing discussion (video and/or audio format), with the possibility of transcribing the exchanges in the GREDEG notebook.

New for the 4th edition: The Poster session

Doctoral students are invited to prepare a poster on their research topic, which will be exhibited at GREDEG during the event. They will be able to discuss their work during the coffee and/or lunch breaks.

The poster session is open to all doctoral students, without exception.

The printing of the poster can be covered by the laboratory (on condition of sending it to us no later than <u>December 15, 2023</u>). The doctoral student will have the opportunity to keep the poster for re-use at future conferences.
